*34 of 144 Were Theft from Vehicle



2013


MOST PART I CRIME IN 2017 OCCURRED DURING THE EVENING FROM NOON TO MIDNIGHT

- Area around 38th St and Liberty Ave




Comparison of Part I Crime by Tract
