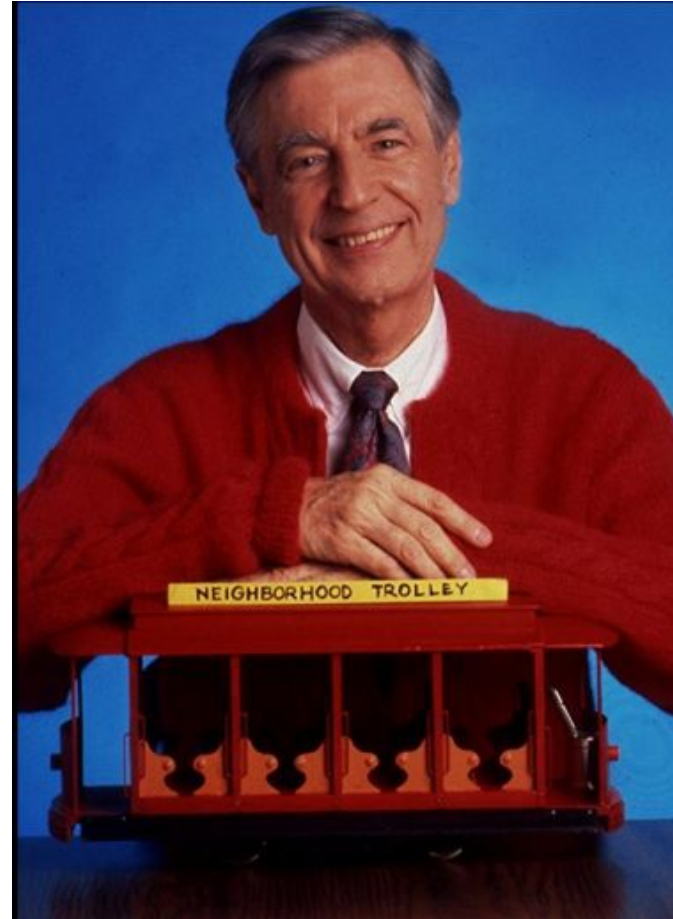

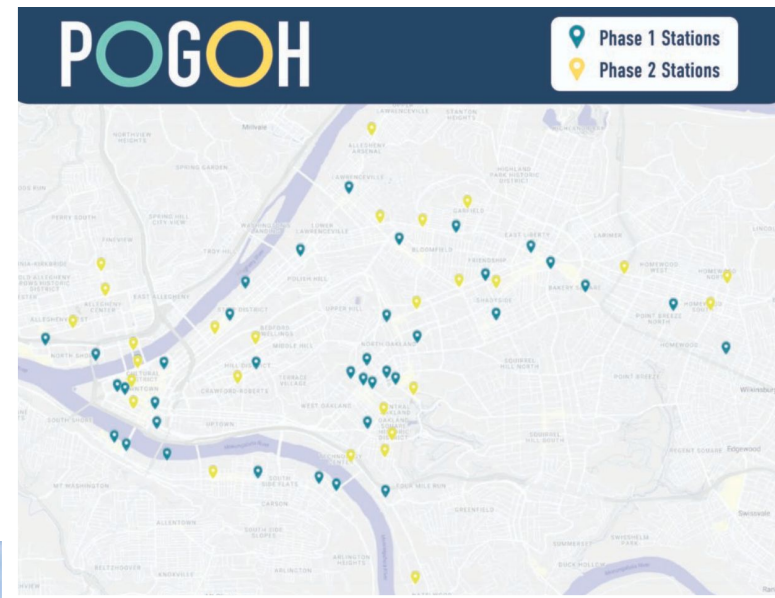

- Includes e-assist and traditional pedal
- New pricing system
- No longer dockless
- Lawrenceville Stations:
 - ◆ Phase 1: 42nd & Butler; 36th & Butler
 - ◆ Phase 2: Stanton & Butler, Main & Penn

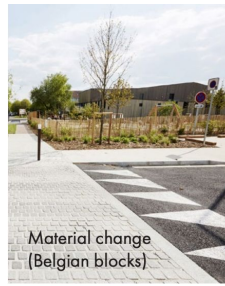

Green Boulevard Commuter Path

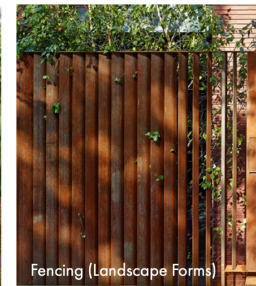

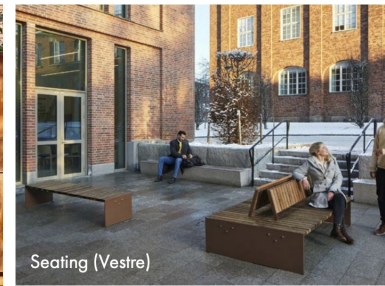

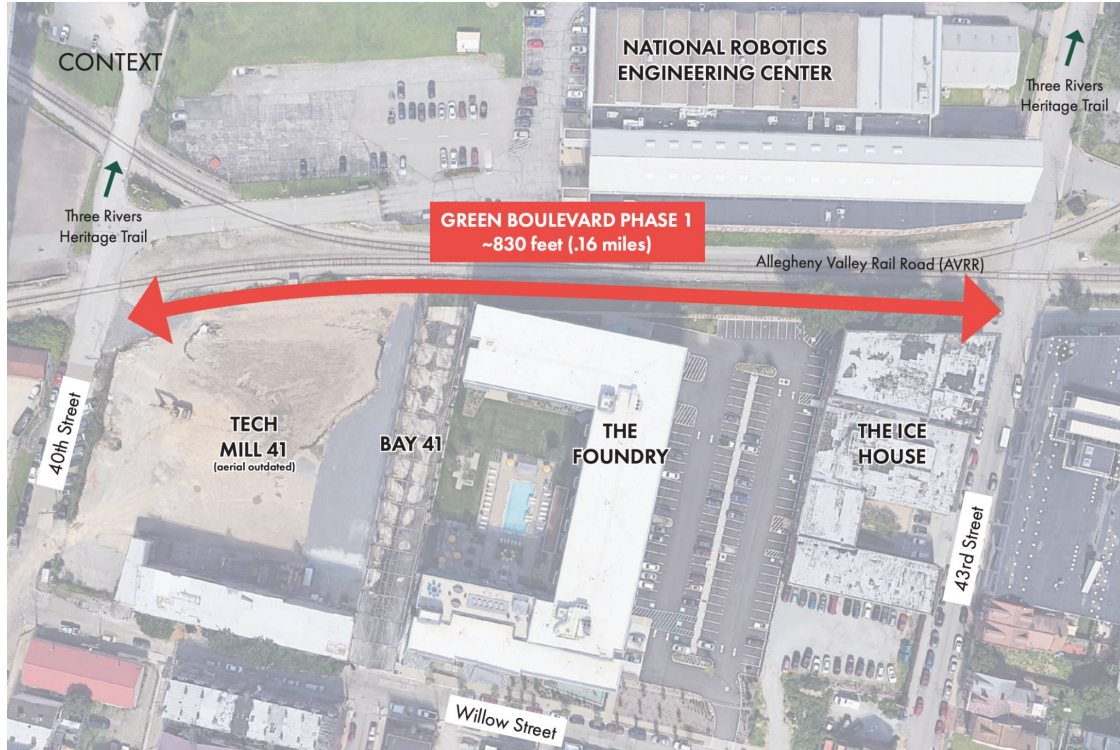
