




PITTSBURGH CRIME INCIDENTS: 2017-2022







Citywide Part 1:Person Crime Incidents by Year





Heat Map: Citywide All Part I Crimes (Full Year 2022)





Citywide: Calls for Shots Fired (Full Year 2022)







Lawrenceville Part 1: Person Crime Incidents by Year: 2017-2022










Lawrenceville Part 1: Property Crime Incidents by Year: 2017-2022




Lawrenceville- Part I: Violent Crimes (Full Year 2022)






Lawrenceville Overdoses (All Call Types) by Year: 2018-2022





Takeaways:

- ➤ Citywide, crime is slightly up compared to last year, however still below the 5 year average, and significantly below pre-pandemic levels;
- ➤ Crime has concentrated in the Central Business District in 2022, compared to previous years;
- ➤ In Lawrenceville, crime is up compared to pandemic years, but down compared to the 5yr average:
 - ➤ Violent crime increases are driven by aggravated assaults;
 - Property crimes had increases particularly in auto thefts and theft from auto;
 - Disorder crimes are down compared to historical averages;

Mobility / Parking Changes

Problems

- Failing public infrastructure for mobility in Lawrenceville. City resources alone have been inadequate to address many needs Lawrenceville has to offer safe rights of way for all
- Parking is poorly managed in Lawrenceville, which is only getting worse with a growing residential and business population.

Mobility Enhancement District

- Legislation introduced by Councilwoman Gross
- Would create dedicated, locally controlled source of funds for mobility improvements in Lawrenceville from:
 - New meters along Butler Street
 - Nighttime enforcement of meters
 - Dynamic pricing would capture extra revenue when demand at its peak
 - Possibility of creating hybrid zones for both paid and permit parking
- South Side Parking Enhancement District
 - Hours of enforcement extends until 3 AM on streets/lots
 - Has generated \$1.24M since 2017
 - Changed Residential Permit Parking enforcement to noon-midnight
